#### § 141.18 Entry by non -Resident Corporation.

A nonresident corporation (*i.e.*, one which is not incorporated within the Customs territory of the United States or in the Virgin Islands of the United States) shall not enter merchandise for consumption unless it:(a) Has a resident agent in the State where the port of entry is located who is authorized to accept service of process against such corporation; and (b) Files a bond on Customs Form 301, containing the bond conditions set forth in § 113.62 of this chapter having a resident corporate surety to secure the payment of any increased and additional duties which may be found due.

§ 141.37 Additional requirements for nonresident corporations. If a nonresident corporation has not qualified to conduct business under state law in the state in which Customs district the agent is empowered to perform the delegated authority, the power of attorney shall be supported by documentation establishing the authority of the grantor designated to execute the power of attorney on behalf of the corporation.
